In mathematics I will concentrate on

- Multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000
- Geometry - reflection and translation. Identify, describe and represent the position of a shape following a reflection or translation.
- Use properties of shapes to deduce facts and missing sides/angles.
- Fractions - recognising and understanding mixed numbers and improper fractions
- Measures - estimating volume & capacity. Converting between different units of metric measure.
- Statistics - interpreting information presented in a line graph accurately.

In geography I will be

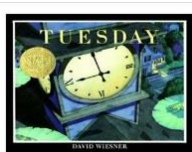
- Learning about the water cycle
- Knowing where we get our water from and how it is treated
- Understanding how and why it rains
- Comparing how people in other areas around the world get water
