

## Pupil's Results at Key Stage 1 - 2016

The following table provides comparative data for the whole cohort.

As these are the first end of key stage results reporting on the new curriculum, there is no national comparative data this year.

### Key to Teacher Assessment Results:

**GDS** is awarded if the pupil is working at greater depth at the expected standard.  
**EXS** is awarded if the pupil is working at the expected standard.  
**WTS** is awarded if the pupil is working towards the expected standard.  
**PKF** is awarded if the pupil is working at foundations for the expected standard.  
**BLW** is awarded if the pupil is below the expected standard.

**HNM** is awarded if the pupil has not met the expected standard. This is only awarded in science where there are only two judgements that can be submitted - **EXS** (working at the expected standard) and **HNM** (has not met the standard).

Where a pupil is working below the expected standard (**BLW**), a further judgement is made using **P scales**.
