

Pupil's Results at Key Stage 2 - 2016

Key Stage 2 Assessment 2016
96.4% of children achieved the expected standard in reading. 39% of children achieved a higher level of attainment in reading. The average scaled score in reading was 109.6. The average progress in reading from KS1 to KS2 was +5.2.
71.4% of children achieved the expected standard in writing. 14% of children achieved a higher level of attainment in writing.
96.4% of children achieved the expected standard in mathematics. 43% of children achieved a higher level of attainment in mathematics. The average scaled score in mathematics was 108. The average progress in mathematics from KS1 to KS2 was +4.
