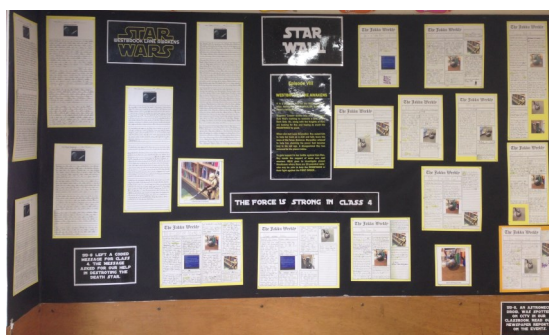


# Westbrook Lane Newsletter

## Changes to School Dinner Money

Please note that the price of school meals is increasing to £2.35 per day with effect from 18th April

For anyone wishing to pay dinner money for the full half term after the Easter holiday the amount needed for children having a school meal every day is:

**Y3, Y4 & Y5 29 days x £2.35 = £68.15. Y6 28 days x £2.35 = £65.80.**

This takes into account the bank holiday and Y6 transition day for high school.
